### Computer Usage Information

#### Personal Equipment

All 2015 Program for Women and Mathematics attendees are encouraged to use their wireless devices on one of two wireless networks while on the IAS campus - **IAS-Conference** and **eduroam**.

- **IAS-Conference** - Access to this wireless network requires registering your wireless device for use on that wireless network. Simply select **IAS-Conference** as your wireless network and then launch your preferred web browser to complete the registration process.
- **eduroam** - For those program attendees affiliated with an institution that supports eduroam authentication, simply select the **eduroam** wireless network and then launch your preferred web browser. No further steps are required.

#### Printing

Once connected to one of the two wireless networks, program attendees will be able to print to printers in Simonyi Hall from their own wireless device. Black and white printing is available just outside of S-114 via print queues **s1** (single-sided printing) or **s1d** (duplex printing). Color printing is available in the lower level of Simonyi Hall in the public computing area next to S-002 via print queues **color** (single-sided printing) or **colord** (duplex printing).
